

## Would you like to donate to the Rescue!

These are the <u>Food types</u> that are needed at the rescue! <u>If You can buy just 1 bag or item it would help!</u> Most of our food and such we purchase through Murdock's of Laramie. 3322 Grand Ave, Laramie Wyoming 307-721-1733 No need to deliver we will pick it up!

## These are Food things that are needed at the Rescue. Remember that we can write a tax donation letter as we are a 501-c-3.

Hay – Local/timothy average \$250- \$450 a ton as hay prices fluctuate

- Purchased locally from a local ranch (Let me know if you would like to help with this)
- We go through approx. 1.5 to 2 ton a week
- 80-100 ton This is one years' worth of hay for the rescue
- This is fed year-round as free choice

Alfalfa Pellets – We use the Wyoming or Montana grown pellets or cubes

- 12 ton this is one years' worth of pellets/cubes (we go through one ton a month on average)
- We hot soak it so that it is a mash.
- It helps the pregnant does and to help put weight on those that come into the rescue.

Sweet Feed – We use Rocky Mountain Sweet

- 12 ton - this is one years' worth of grain (we go through one a month on average)

Goat Salt Blocks – We use Purina Goat Blocks 33#

- 20 salt blocks are the average in a year

Loose minerals – We use Purina Goat Mineral 25#

- These covers more of the macro nutrients that the goats need to stay healthy
- We go through 22-25 bags a year depending on the number of goats we get in that are not

healthy – This is an easier way to give them the minerals that they need in quick way.

Stock Mineral blocks – We use Nutrena all stock block

- This is a free choice block

- We go through 12 – 15 a year

Goat Electrolytes – We use Vitamins and Electrolytes – Durvet

- This is mostly used in the summer or for very sick goats that we need to get fluids in to help them survive illnesses.

- We go through approx. 20-30 a year

Goat Treats - We use Manna pro - Goat treats + Probiotics Licorice Flavor

- We also use - Manna pro peppermint nuggets

- Along with any horse or goat treats out there!

- Goats love treats! It also helps us be able to work with those that have come to us abused or neglected to learn to trust us.

Molasses - I purchase this in bulk through any store or online

- We use this to help goats want to eat when they are sick

All-flock – we use either country Companion or Nutrena all flock 20% protein

- The reason we use this is due to the fact that chicken feed can kill goats, this also helps feed the geese, ducks and all other birds.

- We go through 12 ton a year each ton is approx. 40bags

Sunflower Seeds w/shells - We use Nature's Beauty wild bird seed or Nature's Own Bird food

- These help the birds stay healthy and to keep their feathers shinny

- We go through 4-6 bags a year

Dog food – We use Rancher's choice Active Choice Dog Food

- This is for the LGD's (livestock guardian dogs) they protect the herd from predators

- 40 bags a year or 1 ton

Puppy food – We use Taste of the Wild Grain Free Roasted Venison and Bison High Prairie Formula – Puppy Dry Dog food

- This is for the cattle dogs and puppies to keep healthy
- 40 bags a year or 1 ton

Dog treats – We use Milk Bone 10 lbs.

- We use just about any treats except rawhide treats due to health issues.

- Dogs need treats too!

-They go through about 1-2 bag/box a month
