These are the <u>Medications and Med supplies</u> that are needed at the rescue! <u>If You can buy just 1 item it would help!</u> Most of our food and such we purchase through Murdock's of Laramie. 3322 Grand Ave, Laramie Wyoming 307-721-1733 No need to deliver we will pick it up!

These are medical things that are needed at the Rescue. Remember that we can write a tax donation letter as we are a 501-c-3.

Medications and Med. Supplies that we need!

Pro-bios - we will take the tube/feed granules/oral boluses for ruminants

- we use this to help restart the rumen in the goats/ cows
- These are needed year-round
- tubes we use 10-12 a year
- granules and boluses about 2-3 tubs a year

Nutri-Drench – Goat and Sheep or Dairy and Beef

- This helps us get emergency nutrients into sick or ill animals.
- We go through about 6+ of these bottles a year

Lamb and Kid Paste Durvet/ Lamb and Kid Selenium and Vit. E gel

- Used when babies are first born (we use 1-2 tubes per baby that is born on the farm)
- We also use it for very sick goats to help give them a boost to reset their immune system

Bleed Stop - or Quick Clot

- This is needed as goats get injured and it keeps their blood loss minimal

Disposable syringes – 3ml/5ml/10ml

- These are always something that we need!
- We go through 100's a year in each size from vaccines to boosters, wound cleaning and so much more

Disposable Needles – 20G x 1-1/2" Aluminum Hub Needle 18G 1" and 22G 1" We use 100's each year Approx 3-4 boxes a year (1 box is 100 needles)

Tape (medical tape any kind)

- 1" 2" or 4"

- We need this to hold wraps and or stuff together

Bo-Se (Selenium and Vit E) – Injectable or Tubes

- This helps with proper muscle growth and development
- We go through 2-3 tubes a year
- We go through one bottle a year

Terramycin eye ointment – for eye injuries – any brand We use 2-3 tubes

Vetericyn – Antimicrobial All Animal Wound and Skin Care

- We use this when there are minor injuries this helps keep it clean
- 2-3 bottles a year

DMSO – Anti-inflammatory

- We go through 4-5 bottles a year

Four Oaks Farm Ventures – Goat Hoof and Coat powder

- This helps with hoof rot, ringworm, hot spots, and more
- We go through 3-4 bottles a year

Ammonia Chloride – any brand

- -This is used for bucks and wether to keep them from urinary calculi
- we go through 4-6 tubs a year

Vet Detox – Activated Charcoal

- Goats like to eat things that they should not, this helps coat their stomachs
- We go through 2 tubs a year

Cooper Bolus for Adult Goats - Any brand

- This is for the goats that come in and are copper deficient, without copper goats can get have paralysis and spinal cord issues among other problems.

Fly Spray – Revenge Barn & Stable Fly Spray

- We get fly's and they bother and annoy the animals
- We go through 4 bottles a year
- Vitamin B complex Oral Gel
- We use this when the animals are really sick and need a boost for health
- All new moms get a dose or two after birth of this as it helps keep them healthy and a boost

Vitamin B Complex – Injectable

- This is a faster way to get the nutrients into the animals

- 2 large bottles

Hydrogen Peroxide – Any brand We go through about a case or 12 bottles a year

Rubbing Alcohol We go through about a case or 12 bottles a year

Bio - Silk

Gauze Squares - 2x2 and 4x4 We go through 40+ packages

Gause Wrap rolls 2" and 4" We go through 40+ rolls

Vet Wrap – any color We go through 40+

Sterile surgical blades – We go through about 4 packs of 12

Diatomaceous Earth We use this as part of my dust bath for fleas and other insects that bother the animals

Python Dust – Insecticide We use this for biting insects and dust everyone 4 x a year We use about 4-6 shaker cans a year

Flunixin - Vetameg – non steroid anti-inflammatory med We use 1-2 bottles a year

Thermometer – digital We go through 6+ a year

Antibacterial Ointment tubes We go through 20+ tubes a year

Scissors – Metal, Gauze cutting scissors We go through 2 or more a year

Red Cell - We use this a nutrient supplement We go through about 4 bottles a year

Milk of Magnesium This helps when goats eat things that they should not and or when they are sick

Betadine – Wound Care We go through 3-4 bottles a year Alcohol Wipes – Quick Clean for an area – this is for nicks and cuts We go through 5+ boxes a year

Dewormer for Goats – We use both families of dewormer

Disposable Gloves – We go through 6-7 boxes of Medium Gloves We go through 6-7 boxes of Large Gloves

What we have to get from a veterinarian

LA 300 – We go through about 3 large bottles We can use LA 200 – we just have to use more

Bar-VAC CD/T – We give this 2x a year to every goat and go through 6-8 bottles a year

Antibiotics – Injectable
